IdeaPaint gives you the space you need to think, create and collaborate. It works like a charm when you treat it well. Follow these simple tips to keep your walls happy + perform their best.



WRITE

We've tried every marker under the sun, so you don't have to. We recommend **IdeaPaint dry erase markers**. Don't have any on hand? Expo® BOLD works well too. Otherwise, test the erasability of your marker of choice in a small area before taking the plunge.

ERASE

For best results, use our handy, disposable **foam erasers or microfibre cloths** on a regular basis. Want to leave your work up for a few days? Go for it! If it looks like your writing is sticking around after a good erasing, it's probably time to switch to cleaning mode.



CLEAN

Avoid build-up over time, and extend the life of your IdeaPaint surfaces by using water + microfibre cleaning cloths, at least **once or twice a month**. For stubborn ink spots, use IdeaPaint cleaner + microfibre clean cloths. **Do not use cleaners like Windex or Clorox**. We've seen what happens when people go rogue. It's not pretty.

HAVING AN OOPS MOMENT?

Accidentally use a permanent marker? It happens! **Try this:** Cover the mark with a black dry erase marker. Use an IdeaPaint microfibre cloth + IdeaPaint cleaner to remove the mark.
